Moving basics:

Basic Movements





Move backwards as shown

Move forward as shown



Turning: Rotate wheel in desired direction and spin arm pedals forward or back as desired.

Steep hills



Going up: go up BACKWARDS



Going down: hold arm brake BETWEEN arm pedals

Getting On and Off

From a similar height surface:



1) Set brake on Mobility Cart and move to edge of surface.



Transfer to surface.

4) Place body in the center of surface.



 Place legs in the correct place.



From the ground:



4) Lift

body to

seat of

cart and

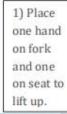

2) Set brake on Mobility Cart and lift to edge of cart.



3) Place legs in the center of the cart.





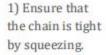
Maintenance

Chain (to be checked every two months):

- * Grease/oil the chain
- * Tightness (if chain is loose follow the images below to tighten):



3) Loosen T-bolts and lift with wood.





2) Hold up with wood and tighten the T-bolts.

Moving parts (to be checked every two months):

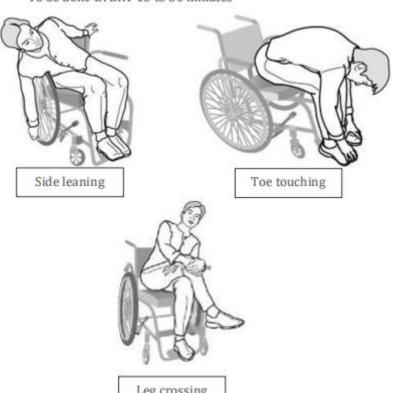
* Grease/oil all parts that move indicated below (use bicycle oil or vegetable oil)

*** To be done EVERY 15 to 30 minutes ****



Leg crossing

Pressure sore prevention:

- *** Need to check skin daily***
 - use mirrors to see where not possible.



^{***} Need to maintain dry and dean skin***

Items that need one to follow up BEFORE a scheduled appointment:

*** Broken Mobility Cart

- Reddened skin
- Pain
- Does not turn white when pressed

- *** Pain in back
- *** Positioning changes
- *** Change in breathing patterns when sitting in Mobility Cart
